

**PROVISIONAL RESOLUTION BY THE SELECTION COMMITTEE FOLLOWING  
A CALL BY THE CENTRE D'ESTUDIS DEMOGRÀFICS (CED) FOR APPLICANTS  
TO FILL TWO TEMPORARY POSITIONS IN THE AMBIT OF RESEARCH**

**R103/2022, INTERINEQ**

Since, according to the OTM-R recruitment protocols of the CED, a Selection Committee has to evaluate candidates for positions for periods of greater than one year, and this Committee has to publish the results of the evaluation and the criteria applied (which are listed in the annex).

Since the aforesaid announcement of vacant positions establishes that only one contract can be awarded and that the proposed award of the contract will follow the order of priority of the candidates.

Since in the event of a greater number of candidates who satisfy the criteria of evaluation, they must all be listed in order to occupy reserve places to cover the withdrawal or cancellation by the candidates selected. If one of those candidates cannot take up the position, the right will pass to the third candidate in the classification, and so successively until the reserve list is exhausted.

**One.** To approve the following list of candidates who have satisfied the criteria of evaluation:

2. 1975
3. 8772
4. 3987

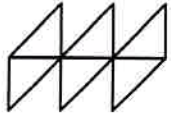
**Two.** To approve the provisional award of the contracts offered to the candidates referenced: 9010.

**Three.** To approve the provisional award of reserve places to the candidates in the following order of priority: (2) 1975, (3) 8772, and (4) 3987.

**Four.** To publish this provisional resolution on the web and on the notice board of the Centre d'Estudis Demogràfics, where it will be on display for a period of ten days counting from its date of signature. This resolution is also communicated to the persons concerned by email.
